Stingray to the Sea Paves the Way



All participants stepped off from Ogden Park at 5:00AM and ran/rucked a direct 5-mile route to Wrightsville Beach State Park just in time for a bootcamp on the beach at Baywatch. Following the workout, everyone regrouped and ran/rucked the 5-mile route back, returning around 10AM.

On Saturday September 17th from 9 am to 1 pm, PAX volunteers and their familes gathered for an extensive work day at the Eden Village construction site at 1302 Kornegay Ave.

Thomas Construction led construction teams, where volunteers installed stairs and ramps on the first 11 homes. PAX also spent time writing scripture on the community center wall studs.

Previously, F3CapeFear raised \$40,000 to sponsor a home in Eden Village, https://edenvillagewilmington.org - a 31-unit tiny home community in development for the chronically homeless to get people off the streets and into a secure, self-sustaining environment.

We have identified the veteran who will be living in our house, who found us through Vigilant Hope and our own Drip. The plan is for F3 Cape Fear to walk alongside him in his journey and have him join us in fitness, fellowship and faith.


